

ARIEL ZUCKERMANN – Flute, Conducting

Ariel Zuckermann studied in Munich with Paul Meisen and András Adorján. He attended master classes with Alain Marion and Aurèle Nicolet and has won numerous awards in international competitions.

He has played with the “Bavaria Radio Orchestra”, “Münchner Philharmoniker”, “Israel Philharmonic Orchestra” and the “Münchner Staatsorchester” conducted variously by Lorin Maazel, Daniel Barenboim, Zubin Mehta and Riccardo Muti. As a soloist, and in chamber music groups, he has toured Israel, Europe and Asia.

Ariel Zuckermann began his second career as a conductor studying with the legendary Jorma Panula and became assistant in 2003 / 2004 to Ivan Fischer, chief conductor of the “Budapest Festival Orchestra”.

He has since conducted many orchestras including the “Israel Philharmonic Orchestra”, “Sinfonieorchester Basel”, “Israel Symphony Orchestra Rishon-Lezion”, “Münchner Symphoniker”, and the “Bayerisches Staatsorchester”. In 2007 he became the principal conductor of the “Georgisches Kammerorchester Ingolstadt”.

Ariel has been a regular member of Kolsimcha since 2000.
